



5/22/11/2017	<p>Performance Update – Andy Nolan</p> <p>Further to the questions posed by BP with regard to the October Performance Report, CI Andy Nolan briefed the meeting on a number of issues:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Both Operation Geode (burglary dwelling) and Operation Diorite (vehicle crime) were ongoing. This had resulted in a pro-active use of resources and intelligence based response with leaflets distributed in areas of high demand. Results were beginning to be realised. Both operations were to remain ongoing. • AN reported that theft from person crime had risen and was now at approximately 2 per day across the County. The Force would be implementing local Christmas operations to include information to the public regarding pick-pockets. • It was noted that MJ had written to the NPCC Lead for Crime Reporting regarding his concerns on data integrity. 	<p>PS to raise the issue of car key crime at regional meeting</p>
