FOI Request regarding: PCC office hours

and attendance

Request received: 12 July 2016 Responded: 20 July 2016

1. A list of the days PCC Philip Seccombe has physically attended the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner between 12<sup>th</sup> May 2016 and 7<sup>th</sup> July 2016.

The Police and Crime Commissioner attended the OPCC office in Warwick on the following dates:-

12<sup>th</sup> May, 13<sup>th</sup> May, 23<sup>rd</sup> May, 24<sup>th</sup> May, 31<sup>st</sup> May, 1<sup>st</sup> June, 7<sup>th</sup> June, 14<sup>th</sup> June, 16<sup>th</sup> June, 17<sup>th</sup> June, 21<sup>st</sup> June, 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 24<sup>th</sup> June, 28<sup>th</sup> June, 30<sup>th</sup> June, 4<sup>th</sup> July.

2. An estimate of the number of hours in which PCC Philip Seccombe has physically attended the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner between 12<sup>th</sup> May 2016 and 7<sup>th</sup> July 2016.

We do not hold the information you request as the office only records scheduled meetings / appointments and does not record office hours of the PCC – therefore the information would be a guesstimate of arrival times and departure time for the PCC in and out of the office which would be inaccurate.

However, we can estimate that the number of hours which the PCC spent in recorded meetings at the OPCC office in Warwick during those days listed above was approximately 56 hours.

There are also considerable additional hours which the PCC has spent in the office dealing with correspondence.

3. A list of the days on which PCC Philip Seccombe has demonstrably been conducting PCC business between 12<sup>th</sup> May 2016 and 7<sup>th</sup> July 2016.

In addition to those days spent at the OPCC office in Warwick. The PCC attended external meetings on the following dates:-

13<sup>th</sup> May, 16<sup>th</sup> May, 17<sup>th</sup> May, 18<sup>th</sup> May, 22<sup>nd</sup> May, 24<sup>th</sup> May, 25<sup>th</sup> May, 26<sup>th</sup> May, 27<sup>th</sup> May, 31<sup>st</sup> May, 1<sup>st</sup> June, 7<sup>th</sup> June, 8<sup>th</sup> June, 9<sup>th</sup> June, 10<sup>th</sup> June, 13<sup>th</sup> June, 14<sup>th</sup> June, 15<sup>th</sup> June,

17<sup>th</sup> June, 21<sup>st</sup> June, 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 24<sup>th</sup> June, 28<sup>th</sup> June, 29<sup>th</sup> June, 30<sup>th</sup> June, 4<sup>th</sup> July, 5<sup>th</sup> July, 6<sup>th</sup> July.

## 4. An estimate of the number of hours in which PCC Philip Seccombe has demonstrably been conducting PCC business between 12<sup>th</sup> May 2016 and 7<sup>th</sup> July 2016.

As detailed in our answer to question 2 above the office only records scheduled meetings / appointments and does not record the incoming and outgoing hours of the PCC – therefore the information is limited to the hours that the PCC attended meetings.

However, we can estimate that the number of hours which the PCC spent in recorded meetings both at the OPCC office in Warwick and outside of the Warwick office is approximately 180 (56 hours spent in recorded meetings at the OPCC office and 124 hours spent in recorded external meetings).

A considerable additional amount of hours is also spent travelling to and from regional and national meetings.
