We will identify the scale of the threat posed by OAC. We will identify those at risk and risk factors/enablers of OAC

We will prioritise partnership working to increase confidence in reporting

We will prioritise intelligence collection. We will raise awareness and Inodering and human trafficking

- What is the extent of child trafficking?
- How are victims being exploited?

- To what extent are victims subject to controlling, coercive, threatening behaviour, violence or abuse?
- What are the links between DA and stalking and harassment?
