

	<p><b>Sale of Southam Police Station</b></p> <p>The Southam site has received offers, with the potential for the building to be converted into supported living flats but there is no planning permission on the site as yet.</p>	<b>Discharged</b>
	<p><b>Police Performance</b></p> <p>In total crime is down to -2% due to the work of the Command Team and enhanced focus on vulnerable victims. Out of the 18 categories of crimes, 3 were showing an increase. Public confidence rose 2 percentage points above the national average, rose from 5<sup>th</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> within the regional group, and from 25<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> nationally.</p> <p>Victim satisfaction also saw a 2% improvement, from 15.9% to 13.9% dissatisfied, and this improvement is generating interest from outside forces.</p>	<b>Discharged</b>

	<p><b>New Policing Model</b></p> <p>It was agreed that the new policing model is proving resilient for the future.</p>	Discharged
