

6/08/05/2019	NEW ITEM: Officer deployment 150 new officers are due to join the Force and PS questioned where the officers will be deployed. MJ advised that the majority of officers would go to Patrol and the rest in other areas such as CID, SNT, and the new Rural Crime Team. However, it was noted that due to varying changes in demand this figure has to be flexible, although officers will not go in staff roles. It was furthermore noted that most new officers start in patrol then progress to other areas.	Ongoing
7/08/05/2019	NEW ITEM: Murder in Bedworth It was noted that arrests have been made over the murder in Bedworth. 3 suspects have been identified and are being interviewed.	Ongoing
8/08/05/2019	NEW ITEM: Warwickshire Elections The election results were discussed. WCC, Nuneaton, Stratford and North Warwickshire have not changed. Mike Stokes is standing down as Leader of Rugby Borough Council. Warwick District is now a hung Council and Andrew Mobbs has lost his seat. There were more Green Party seats in Leamington and Stratford as Labour lost seats. It was noted that this will 'change the face' of the Police and Crime Panel. 
