



6/16/07/2019	<p>NEW ITEM: Bede and Poplar Community Forum</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> PS has attended a number of public events and meetings to reassure people that officers are available to attend crimes. He recently attended the above meeting and was advised on the situation regarding reporting crimes online. Ps advises that reporting crimes online will result in saving officers time. 	Discharged
7/16/07/2019	<p>NEW ITEM: HS2 update, Adrian Davis</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The following was noted: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> HS2 is currently Warwickshire's largest project, with 34 miles of track being in Warwickshire alone, 18 major highway crossings, 71 compounds, and 17 new bridges. HS2 has its own act of parliament, enabling the contractors to build bridges and change traffic regulations. There will be a total of 3.5 million HGV/LGV movements, around 5000 to 8000 per day in Warwickshire. The labourers will work from 7am-7pm and Saturday mornings. They will be both from local and outside areas. The impact on Force resources and Road Safety was discussed. The potential for the Fosse Way speed limit to be reduced to 40mph was discussed. The main contractors are Balfour Beatty Group Ltd, VINCI, and EKJV. The companies have not been given permission to start construction at present. Progress is dependent on the Conservative new leadership. PS will arrange to meet with AD and officers from the HS2 community engagement team. 	Ongoing
