


1/03/09/2019	<b>Record of previous meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> August 2019 were agreed as a true and accurate record.</b>

3/03/09/2019	<p><b>Update on Performance – ACC Alex Franklin Smith</b></p> <p>AFS gave a comprehensive briefing in response to the questions posed within the OPCC Performance Scrutiny Report for July 2019. Discussion ensued on the following -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Victim Satisfaction</b> - Figures for July 2019 indicated a continuing deterioration in victim satisfaction performance compared to July 2018 data AFS reported that whilst 75.8% of victims remained “satisfied” with their whole experience, 18.9% of victims were “dissatisfied” and this indicated a 3% drop from last year</li> </ul> <p>It was noted that Chief Inspector Lee Kemp from the Harm Hub was currently reviewing and would report back in detail at the monthly Performance Review Meeting which DP attended MJ confirmed that victim satisfaction remained a priority for the</p>	<p><b>LK to liaise with DP and CL from the OPCC in</b></p>

	<p>Force and a paper was currently being prepared to review the content of survey's going forward in order to ensure meaningful data could be retrieved NH requested that OPCC be engaged in pulling this paper together to ensure that an overarching approach be taken (surveying, partnership delivery, timely Force updates for victims, drivers from the MOJ and linked in with Criminal Justice)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <p><b>Personal Robbery (North Wark)</b> - Warwickshire had experienced a 24% increase in Personal Robbery Offences constituting a fairly significant reduction in the South versus an increase in the North of the County</p> <p>AFS reported that this had been a challenging area for the Force but focus and resources were being put into this area with statistics now indicating that these figures were reducing significantly Extra police officers, raised from the precept rise, were starting to come through the system which would help pro-active resources</p> </li> <li> <p><b>Business Robbery</b> – It was noted that, although volumes were relatively small, business robbery had increased by 41 2% YTD in Warwickshire, comprising 45 5% increase in North Warks and a 33 3% increase in the South</p> <p>AFS confirmed that YTD data amounted to 7 offences – relatively small numbers across Warwickshire Operation Tempest had been launched in Stratford District a few weeks ago with a lot of pro-active work taking place, daily activity and good feedback</p> <p>In response to a question raised by PS – AFS agreed to report back on a recent business robbery</p> </li> <li> <p><b>RAPE</b> – Discussion ensued on the Force's high level of compliance with crime reporting and the national trend regarding declining detection figures Warwickshire continued to concentrate on improving overall performance in outcomes, providing a service to victims and encouraging reporting</p> </li> <li> <p><b>Total Crime</b> – PS commented on the positive reduction of Total Recorded Crime which was down 1 5% from last year ASB was particularly good and an excellent result of working with partners and problem solving</p> </li> <li> <p><b>Criminal Justice</b> – Figures fluctuated considerably from month to month AFS to discuss with Justice Board</p> </li> </ul>	<p><b>preparing paper</b></p> <p><b>AFS to look into business robbery and report back to PS</b></p> <p><b>AFS to discuss with Justice Board</b></p>
