- Could you please tell me the PCC's annual salary and whether this has remained the same since the post was created in 2012?
 - The PCC's current salary is £66,300. It has risen from £65,000 when the position was created, due to inflationary cost.
- How many members of staff did your office have when it was created in November 2012, and what was the annual salary cost at that time?
 - There were 13 staff in 2012/13.
 - I have been unable to ascertain salary costs for 2012/13, principally due to the transition from the Police Authority to the Police and Crime Commissioner.
 - The financial year 2013/14 represents the first full year of OPCC costs and they were recorded as £1,3841,0000. They have since declined in subsequent years.
- How many members of staff does your office have as of now, January 2020, and what is the current annual salary cost?

- There are 13 staff in January 2019/20.
 - The annual salary costs are estimated at £984,000 whilst awaiting the Annual Statement of Accounts at the end of the financial year.
- 4. How many members of staff are paid an annual salary of more than £100,000 as of now, January 2020?**
- Nil
- 5. How many members of staff has the office employed since November 2012 and what is the total salary cost of this?**
- The number of staff employed since 2012 has remained relatively stable, as the attached table demonstrates.
 - I have been unable to ascertain salary costs for 2012/13, principally due to the transition from the Police Authority to the Police and Crime Commissioner.
 - The total salary costs since 2013/14 are £6,965,000.
