	 Crime is down overall 25.6% Year to Date (YTD). This is above the national average. House burglaries are down 53% YTD. Commercial burglaries are down 39% YTD. There has been a rise in anti-social behaviour (ASB) incidents over the last 7 days. These are mainly COVID19 related e.g. not social distancing, and the Force control room have been managing these effectively. YTD the biggest amount of calls received in the control room have been ASB related, accounting for a 67% increase ASB YTD. 999 calls have decreased overall YTD. Compliance within Warwickshire County is high as the public are staying at home. The Force are using the '4Es' approach, with enforcement being the last option.
