3/19/05/2020	<b>NEW ITEM: COVID19 related matters</b>  <b>The following was noted:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• According to Public Health England, there have been 1379 cases in Warwickshire as of 18/05/2020, plus a reduction in hospital admissions.</li> <li>• 63 care homes in Warwickshire have been affected, this is being dealt with by Public Health England with the Force playing a supportive role if needed.</li> <li>• Demand for Force services has slightly increased due to the warmer weather. There were 130 COVID related calls last week, mainly around minor breaches and social distancing.</li> <li>• The Force have attended 58% of all COVID related calls since the 'stay alert' campaign was launched. 	<p>checks of control room calls are now in place and being monitored.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Force will continue with the '4Es' approach.</li><li>• A recent survey undertaken by Ipsos Mori and Crest has shown that Warwickshire residents are 20% happier and more confident with the service. This is largely due to the Safer Neighbourhood Teams being kept together to maintain a good community relationship.</li><li>• A national campaign for speed has been launched, with speed awareness courses being held online.</li><li>• Refuse and recycling centres are opening on an appointment only basis; the Force will be working alongside WCC if needed, however WCC have advised of no complaints and general compliance by site users.</li><li>• It was also noted that Highways England and British Transport Police have no reported incidents.</li></ul> <p>Closed meeting ensued.</p>
