	checks of control room calls are now in place and being monitored.  The Force will continue with the '4Es' approach.  A recent survey undertaken by Ipsos Mori and Crest has shown that Warwickshire residents are 20% happier and more confident with the service. This is largely due to the Safer Neighbourhood Teams being kept together to maintain a good community relationship.  A national campaign for speed has been launched, with speed awareness courses being held online.  Refuse and recycling centres are opening on an appointment only basis; the Force will be working alongside WCC if needed, however WCC have advised of no complaints and general compliance by site users.
