5/01/09/2020	<b>OCC Performance Report</b>  It was noted that call centre demand had remained challenging over the summer period and impacted further by COVID/complexity of incidents which had resulted in the average call-handling times increasing. Currently recorded data does not reflect the complexity of incidents being reported and a Performance Analyst was currently looking at incident types and variances etc; to ensure resources matched demand more closely going forward.  Recruitment was required into the current six vacant positions and Corporate Comms team were actively promoting online reporting through Single online Home.  It was noted that 101 call waiting times and abandonment rates had seen improvements this week.
