	 Staff sickness levels were decreasing and Force remained resilient. Warwickshire would be continuing their robust approach to issuing Fixed penalty notices Infection numbers had improved quite significantly over the last 7 days – an improving picture across the whole of Warwickshire dropping from 192 infections per 100,000 last week to 156 per 100,000 as of yesterday. Level of crime / demand was down 23% over the last week with an 8% reduction year to date. Burglaries from dwellings down 42% year to date and vehicle crime also down. 				
	 Control room call handling targets had been met at 93% and 101's wait time at 30 seconds. PCC thanked CC Jelley and the Team for the work continually carried out in keeping Warwickshire safe.
