Of particular note :-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Infection levels continued to gradually reduce across Warwickshire and, as of 15th February 2021, stood at 163 per 100,000 population. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Absentee levels across the Force had improved from last week's figures and now stood at 6.46% for officers and 6.88% for staff. 42 Enforcements had been made by Warwickshire Police over the last seven days with the total number of enforcements now approaching 1,000. A small number of front-line police officers (65) had now received a vaccination. Warwickshire had received additional COVID surge funding from Government which would continue to be utilised over the coming months. 	
4/16/02/2021	<p>Chief Constable Retirement</p> <p>Further to the Chief Constable's announcement that he would be retiring from Warwickshire Police at the end of June 2021 – PR outlined the recruitment process that would be undertaken by the OPCS and which would be announced in due course.</p>	Discharged
5/16/02//202	<p>Crime Figures</p> <p>Robust discussion ensued on the wide differentials in crime data figures / statistics which were published by different organisations and were unhelpful to members of the public.</p> <p>MJ reported that Warwickshire crime figures, year to date, were down 12% with burglary from houses within Warwickshire at an unprecedented low.</p> <p>It was noted that, nationally, crime had risen over the last few years due to the higher standards around crime reporting. Members of the public were encouraged to report all crimes.</p>
