2/14/09/2021	<p><b>Operational Updates</b></p> <p><b>Covid update provided by AFS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>As of 13/9/2021 Infection rates regionally are 382 above the national average rate which stand at 242 cases. Cases are continuing to rise with hospital admissions and number of deaths increasing</li> <li>Government has confirmed vaccinations for 12-15 year old</li> <li>Absence rates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>6.5% -offices</li> <li>7% - police staff</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>Data is at a similar rate to what it has been this time of year pre-Covid.</p> <p>Force continue into recovery mode. A new recovery coordination group is being set up.</p>

	<p>PCC gave feedback on his Friday night time economy patrol with the OPU on 3 September 2021. He felt there was a good number of officers on patrol.</p> <p>CC noted demand is still significantly high for this time of year. It was noted an additional 500 calls were received with 300 more 999 calls. There does not appear to be a reason why the summer demand is still holding. The position is the same across the region. It has been agreed regionally to carry out some work on the cause of the increase</p>

4/14/09/2021	<p><b>National Briefings</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Beating the Crime Plan</b> – Brief update was given by the CC and AFS on the governmental strategic approach to cutting crime. The Plan is being reviewed as part of Chief’s Council. PCC noted it was good to see a joint approach being taken by both the Home Office and MOJ. AFS as lead on national burglary will receive updates on burglary.</li> <li>• PCC Review – PCC’s office to submit their call for evidence by 17 September 2021. Copy to be shared with the CC.</li> <li>• PCC’s office responding to consultation on general powers of competence</li> <li>• HMIC – Force responding to the request to consult on the review on the annual assessment of policing</li> <li>• Both the CC and PCC responding to the consultation on the merger around Stratford and Warwick</li> </ul>
5/14/09/2021	<p><b>AOB</b></p> <p><b>Partnership award</b> – The force’s partnership work as part of its county-wide response to COVID has been recognised with a national award. Warwickshire County Council and partners won the Best Collaborative Working Initiative category at the Association for Public Service Excellence (APSE) Awards 2021 on Thursday (9 September).</p> <p><b>Family Day:</b> Both the PCC and CC noted the successful Family Open Day held for staff on Saturday 11 September 2021. The event was well run and well hosted by Matthew Hopley. Going forward the CC would like to plan open days as part of a wider community engagement.</p>
